Yoga for Men

This class will cover some early basics of Yoga. This will be a shorter course addressing areas of common concern for range of movement such as shoulders, hips and knees using a simplified approach to the yoga poses. Participants can join the 5:30 class at the end of 4 weeks if desired.

Iyengar Yoga is an approach to Hatha yoga which gives clear step-by-step directions to achieve each asana or pose. Students gain flexibility, balance, endurance and clarity of movement, as well as clarity of mind and the ability to relax and find inner peace. This class is excellent for cross training in any sport, or as a non-impact approach to wellness. Instructor Mary Reilly is a senior Iyengar certified instructor with over 20 years teaching experience .

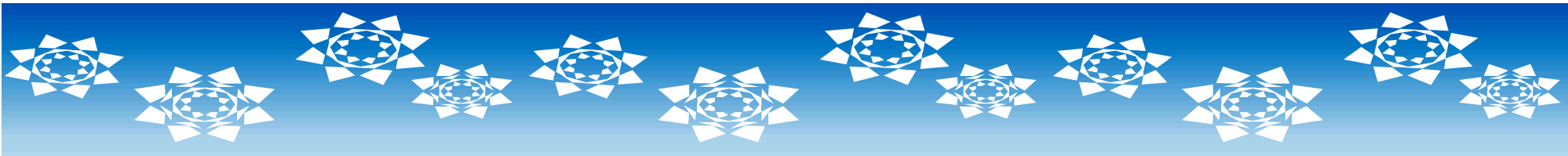
Private one-on-one instruction.

Beginning Ballet (ages 4-6) 3:15-3:45

This class is designed to be a dancer's first class. The premiere function of this class is to impart the five basic ballet positions. Arm placement, pointing of toes, stretching, turnout, poise, and classroom etiquette are all concepts that are learned and relearned each class in a creative manner. The ballet walk is practiced at the end of each class as it encompasses all that a young child may find difficult about the art of ballet. At the end of each session, all students should be able to execute the five positions by name, have a solid basic concept of the way their bodies move and be excited for their next dance class!

Beg/Int Ballet (ages 6-8) 4:00-5:00
\$234 Mondays

Beginning/Intermediate level introduces the young dancer to the true outline of a ballet class. Structured ballet barre with center combinations & French terminology are all composites of this class that shape the students for their future ballet classes. This level is the perfect transition from the beginner's class, however, no prior dance experience is necessary.
