

## Logic Pro X Unit 2

### **Live Loops Lesson 1**

Choose “Live Loops” under “New Project” icon when starting a new file.

#### **1) Live Loops Grid:** Get to know the various icons in the Live Loops Grid

- Live Loop Grid Button & Track Area Button (top left)
- Grid Zoom Button (top right)
- Live Loops Track Layers (rows) vs. Scenes (columns)
- Scene/Column Selector buttons (bottom)
- Live Loop Stop/Clear Button (bottom right)
- Divider Column and Selector Button (between grid and tracks)
- Performance Recording Button (top left inside grid window)

#### **2) Grid Playback:** Use Loop Library to create your Loop Grid.

- Grid can only play one loop per Track/Row
- Grid can play as multiple loops per Section/Column
- Click on individual loops within grid to play
- Click on Section/Column button to play entire section
- Select multiple loops in grid
  - While pressing the “shift” key, click on loop grid
  - Once selected, press “return” to start/stop

#### **3) Recording in Live Loops:**

- Turn on Track window
- Engage Performance Recording
- Play/Record your arrangement
- Stop Recording by pressing Grid Stop

#### **4) Editing Live Loops:**

- Turn Off Performance Recording
- Select Divider Column arrows if needed.
- Regions should turn from grey to blue/green/yellow/etc.
- Edit similar to previous Logic Unit
- Bouncing audio is exactly the same as previous lessons.
